



Jun 12 2023 10:08AM 06.11.23 approx 1654 I arrived at 6207 SE Milwaukie Ave. I was greeted by the vet staff and the dog owner, JAMIE [redacted] whom I had met previously for several complaint, all unfounded. JAMIE stated that last night, her dog "Priest" stepped on a clamp the night before. JAMIE stated that she attempted to get the clamp off the dog but unsuccessful. JAMIE stated that she did not have a phone or transport at this time. JAMIE stated that the next day, she pushed her dog in a shopping cart to Banfield to seek help. The vet staff informed me that they did not have a the proper tool to extract the clamp and the dog would most likely need to be sedated and did not believe JAMIE could pay them. I offered JAMIE transport to Dove Lewis with her dog. JAMIE accepted. The vet staff helped load the dog into my truck and I transported JAMIE and the dog to Dove Lewis. I gave JAMIE my business card to call if she needed any further assistance. I departed, complaint closed.

Feb 8 2023 9:13AM Hello, Our vet hospital staff relayed a concern to us this afternoon. I am checking to see if you have the resources to attempt a welfare check on the dog. OHS was contacted by a person looking for vet care for a dog that was apparently hit by a car yesterday in front of several witnesses. The caller is not the dog owner. The dog owner lives in a tent at Milwaukie and M [REDACTED] directly across from [REDACTED] Milwaukie. I don't have a description of the tent. The hit by car happened yesterday at that location. The dog is reported to be in the tent, not moving,

not eating, crying. The caller thinks the dog is critically injured. The dog is a lab/pit mix, black in color, named Priest. Apparently the dog has been hit by bikes and cars before. The incident yesterday was apparently pretty bad and witnesses may have called someone (we did not get any calls). Caller stated the boyfriend of the dog owner is also physically abusive toward the dog, but the caller will not come forward as a witness and won't provide the name of the owner or suspect. We have no details about the alleged abuse. Our hospital would have seen this dog, but the caller cannot bring it in and states the owner "doesn't have it together" and doesn't have the stability to manage a task like getting the dog in a cab and showing up for an appointment. - Feb 10 2023 9:24AM On 2/9/23 I arrived at the campsite across the street of SE Milwaukie. Due to a previous call, I had been to this location before and interacted with "Priest" and JAMIE. When I arrived, I observed that the tents had been relocated to a different side of the park, so I was unsure which tent would be JAMIE's. I observed three tents in the area, one which had a dog crate placed outside. I called out to JAMIE from outside of that tent but received no response and did not hear anybody. I then went to the other tent I could see and called out to JAMIE as well and received no response. The last time I was out, I observed the dog "Priest" to be vocal and reactive and observed no signs of him today. After receiving no response, I departed.
- Feb 10 2023 11:09AM 2/10/23 at 1018 I arrived at Oaks Bottom Park. I approached the tents and was greeted by JAMIE [REDACTED]. JAMIE stated that "Priest" was hit by a car three days ago when he bolted from the tent late at night. JAMIE stated that a good sam called the police and that the police took her and "Priest" to Dove Lewis. JAMIE stated that Dove Lewis took the vitals of "Priest" and noted that there was no blood in the urine or stool and cleared him as he was stable. JAMIE stated that they did not do X-rays as cost was an issue and Dove recommended that if "Priest" is still limping, that they go to a cheaper vet for a follow up appointment in a few days. I asked JAMIE to see "Priest" and I observed that "Priest" was alive and stable but was limping on his back right leg. I explained to JAMIE that "Priest" needs a follow up exam and to get x-rayed to know if he has any fractures. I told JAMIE I would be back next week to confirm that he has been seen or that an appointment has been made. JAMIE stated that she has a support group helping her raise money and that she will work on getting him into a vet ASAP. I then asked JAMIE if she has a phone number and she stated that she does not but that I can have the number of her camp mate who is co-watching "Priest" with her at this time. A man named TODD came out of the tent and gave me his number [REDACTED]. I thanked JAMIE and departed. I called Dove Lewis and confirmed that JAMIE did bring "Priest" into their care on 2/5/23 and was discharged with pain medication and advised follow up care if he does not improve or gets worse.
- Feb 16 2023 10:37AM 2/16/23 at approx. 1030 I arrived at SE Milwaukie. I saw "Priest" sitting up right and alert with another woman. I asked if JAMIE was around and the woman stated that JAMIE will be back later today and that she agreed to watch "Priest" until she is back. The woman then stated that "Priest" is continuing to improve each day but was unsure about the x-rays. I thanked her and departed.
- Feb 17 2023 11:36AM 2/17/23 at 1100 I arrived at SE Milwaukie. I observed "Priest" on lie out around multiple people. I could see he was wearing a brand new coat that still had tags, and was bearing more weight on his leg than last time, but was still favoring it. I met JAMIE and asked if she was able to get a vet appointment. JAMIE mentioned that TODD after hours on the phone, was able to get a voucher for a free x-ray. I asked JAMIE if TODD was around and she stated that he was not. I called TODD and he confirmed that he had been granted a voucher for a free x-ray but that he needed to pick it up in Gresham. I asked TODD if there was anything I could do to help and he stated that he was fine and that he would pick it up soon. TODD then thanked me for my help and we hung up. I then spoke to JAMIE and explained that she should keep moving forward with making the appointment but I am glad to see improvement in "Priest." JAMIE agreed that she definitely wants the x-ray, she's just been waiting to get approval for a free one via the voucher. I asked JAMIE if she needed any help and she stated that she was fine for now. I thanked JAMIE and stated that I would check back next week and would like to see an appointment made since they now have the voucher. JAMIE expressed understanding and I departed.
- Mar 1 2023 2:11PM 3/1/23 at approx. 1400 I arrived back at the park. The camping here has been cleared and I am unable to get a hold of TODD. Because "Priest" was improving with my visits, JAMIE was actively working on getting him continual care, and I no longer have contact with JAMIE due to the camp being cleared, I will close this complaint.

Nov 19 2022 3:24PM PR states that she works for street response and has a client who isn't properly caring for their dog (small black dog with white patch on chest). PR states that the dog is owned by a couple and the male consistently hits the dog and the dog was ran over by a bicycle about two weeks ago and is limping (PR requested not mentioning the bike issue, as it would give her away). PR is requesting a welfare check. Camping in a tent (brown tarp over it) right across street from

listed property. First tent by the parking lot. PR requested to be left anonymous. *****ANON



Nov 20 11.20.22 approx 1255 I arrived at 5120 SE Milwaukie Ave. I noted a large tent and campsite
2022 from across the listed address. From the PRs description, I knew the dog owners to be JAMIE
1:15PM AND ANTONIO. I heard a woman yell out ANTONIOS name from inside the tent and a
dog barking. I announced my presence and JAMIE stated she did not feel comfortable with me
talking to her without her partner. I informed JAMIE that I understood and I went back to my
truck. I waited for approx 15 minutes and ANTONIO had not returned. I will return tomorrow for a
follow up.

Nov 29 11.29.22 as I am going on vacation for the next week, I will place this as an awaiting assignment
2022 for a district officer to follow up.
5:38PM

Dec 1 12/1/22 I arrived at the location listed and found "Prince" off leash while JAMIE was attempting
2022 to recall him. I asked JAMIE how I could help and she stated that "Prince" would not listen to
3:40PM her. JAMIE then stated that she has a back injury and cannot move fast enough to get "Prince."
After some time, a person who "Prince" was fond of arrived and jumped into their arms. JAMIE
was then able to leash "Prince." I explained to JAMIE that "Prince" needs to have a collar or
harness on at all times. I also suggested that she keeps "Prince" on tie down with supervision if
she is unable to handle him due to her injuries. I explained to JAMIE that we can ticket for this
and will let her off with a warning this time but further violations will lead to citation. During this
interaction, I observed "Prince" to be in ideal condition and was not limping. I then explained the
reason of the visit to JAMIE. JAMIE explained that sometimes ANTONIO yells at "Prince" and
can handle him rough but he does not abuse the dog. I then explained to JAMIE that "Prince"
appears to be in ideal condition but suggested she tells ANTONIO to handle him gentler or we
maybe have to visit them again. JAMIE expressed understanding. I thanked her and departed.

She visit frequently & has noticed that the dog is often without water & is tied to a tree consistently & appears to be under fed. She also states she knows that the boyfriend has hit the dog. The dog owner is Jamie [REDACTED] & her boyfriend goes by Antonio [REDACTED]. Jamie is currently suffering from a mental crisis.

Sep 4 2022 3:43PM 08.31.22 approx 1610 I arrived at 5040 SE Milwaukie Ave. I greeted a couple that were located next to the address in a tent. I asked them if they had a dog. The man stated that he did not but was aware of the dog dog and dog owner in question. The man stated that the dog owners, JAMIE and ANTONIO were a houseless couple who lived inside the Oaks Bottom Wildlife Refuge - North Parking & Trailhead with a black dog. The man stated that the dog is known to be aggressive and is known to be tied to the trees for long periods of time. The man stated that he has watched the dog on several occasions for days at a time before JAMIE comes back. The man stated he was unsure if the dog had access to food and water. I thanked the man and departed. I walked towards the park and was greeted by ANTONIO. I informed ANTONIO of the complaint. ANTONIO led me down the incline where the camp and the dog was located. I was greeted by JAMIE who was with the dog. I could see the dog was leashed and had access to water, food, and shelter. I informed JAMIE of the complaint. JAMIE stated that the dog is with her most of the day as the dog wil cry as a result of separation anxiety, but if the dog is left, it always has food, water and access to shelter. I noticed the dog "Priest" to appear to be healthy and in ideal condition. I asked JAMIE if she need any dog food or a muzzle for the dog. JAMIE stated that she would be interested in a muzzle as she was planning on staying in a shelter soon with the dog and the muzzle would be required. I brought a bag of dog food, two bowls, and one size 4 and size 5 muzzle. I gave JAMIE my business card to contact me if she needed anymore resources. I thanked JAMIE and ANTONIO and departed. Compliant closed as no violations were found and resources given.
