- Dog- Handling Sensitivity

The dog that you are adopting has either a history of being sensitive to certain handling in their previous home or we have observed the dog being sensitive to certain handling in the shelter environment. With proper intervention this behavior can be managed in their new home.

Why are some dogs sensitive about handling?

Some dogs do not like to be handled or touched in certain areas or may struggle when any amount of physical restraint is involved. There are many different circumstances which may have led to this behavior such as lack of puppy socialization, painful grooming or nail trimming. By using gentle, slow handling you can build a trusting relationship with your dog and you will be able to manage and possibly modify this behavior.

How do I help my dog adjust to handling?

This dog will require ongoing work with this behavior once in a new home. The following tips can help you and your new dog work together:

\* Most dogs will show you when they are uncomfortable by their body language. They may get up and leave, stiffen or freeze, lick their lips, tuck their tail, flatten their ears or vocalize with a growl or whine. It is important to listen to these signals and not push them past their comfort levels.

\* Work with your veterinarian to rule out any medical reasons for the handling sensitivity. Dogs with chronic ear infections or arthritis are going to be more sensitive regarding the areas that are painful to them.

\* If you find areas in which this dog prefers not to be touched, either avoid these areas or you may work on helping the dog become more comfortable with you touching these areas. Find something this dog really likes and then only give these particular treats when he allows you to lightly touch in these areas. This will help the dog learn that touching means good things, which will lead to gradual acceptance of such handling.

\* It is important to go slowly and not push the dog beyond current comfort levels. With patience and by going slowly, this dog will progress and gradually accept greater levels of handling and restraint.

What if my adopted dog shows any handling sensitivity in the new home?
