Readily took treats from me. Allowed me to pet her without cowering, let me pet her face, neck, and shoulders without issue. Focused on the cheese I had in my hand. Gretchen is very treat motivated. When the cheese was gone she laid down nearby and looked at me. CT came with more treats and she was hesitant for a moment but then approached him and took treats and received pets. Will steal treats from Holly. Holly was a little slower to approach me but also readily ate treats from my hands. When the

treats were gone she laid down nearby and didn't get up until CT entered. Tolerated pets from him and took treats from him, a little stiffer body and elevated breathing but no trembling or panting. When we exited and opened the inside door both dogs ran inside and looked at us with ears perked, did not run back out; this behavior is different than previously observed. Have not yet attempted to get them out of the kennel.

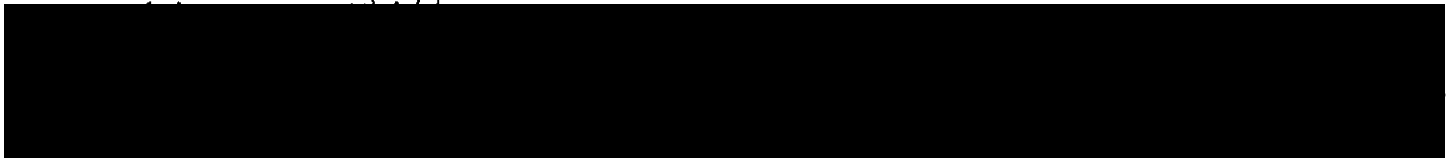

- Kennel Cough

The dog that you are adopting has been treated for Canine Infectious Respiratory Disease Complex (commonly called Kennel Cough) or may be at risk for developing it.

What causes kennel cough?

The most common cause is from a Bordetella bronchiseptica bacterial infection, though several viruses may also be involved. Dogs may enter the shelter already infected or they may acquire these pathogens in the shelter, similar to a person catching a cold from a public place.

What are the common signs?

The most common sign is a hacking cough, though sneezing, eye discharge and nasal discharge may develop. A foamy mucus is sometimes produced after the coughing episodes, which may be confused with vomit. In severe cases, the dog may have a poor appetite, difficulty breathing or be lethargic. Kennel cough is usually self-limiting, but it can persist for several weeks.

Is kennel cough contagious?

Kennel cough is highly contagious to other dogs. If the dog you are adopting currently has kennel cough, he/she should be kept separate from other household dogs for at least 2 weeks after all signs resolve. This also includes avoiding contact with other dogs outside of the home, such as at the park or on walks. It is the responsibility of the adopter to provide treatment for other household dogs that develop kennel cough.

What if my adopted dog shows signs of kennel cough?

If the dog has clear nasal discharge and is eating, drinking and otherwise acting normally, then a vet appointment may not be needed. However, we should still be contacted when kennel cough develops so this can be noted in our records. Most mild episodes resolve on their own in 1-2 weeks. If the dog has more severe signs, such as colored nasal discharge, lethargy, fever or a poor appetite, then a vet appointment is recommended.

If your adopted dog develops kennel cough within the first fourteen (14) days after adoption, please contact us at (503) 988-9075 to schedule an appointment at MCAS. If signs develop after fourteen (14) days of adoption, it is the responsibility of the adopter to provide treatment.
