Oct 16 10/16 at 3pm I met with YOLA [REDACTED] and her family. Yola told me that the evening prior to
 2023 Teddy's (formerly Bear) passing, he seemed slightly "off". Yesterday morning she became
 3:59PM concerned when he showed little interest in food and seemed withdrawn. She actually called
 the vet and described his symptoms and was told to keep an eye on him and call back if or
 come in if his condition didnt improve. She said that when she brought him outside to potty in
 the evening, that he sort of dove into a bush and vomited a small amount of food and bile. He
 collapsed and died moments later. I expressed my condolences and let them know we would
 cover his cremation and paw print if they'd like to have his ashes back. They said they would
 like that. I transported him to FAS and provided them JT's contact and advised MCAS is
 covering private cremation and paw print for the family. FAS will contact JT when Teddy is
 ready for pick up.

Aug 25 2023 2:45PM 08.25.23 I arrived at this location to assist ACO L [REDACTED]. As we began trying to contain the 4 unsocialized lab type dogs I heard ACO L [REDACTED] speak to the residents. The resident stated that they had agreed to watch a female dog and a litter of puppies for an unnamed person who had to move off of a pot farm and into a van. The agreement was that the resident was going to watch the female "for a while" in exchange for being able to keep 2 of the puppies. The resident stated that last night they came out to find these 4 adult dogs running loose in the yard and speculated that the same person, or an associate and dropped them off. The resident stated they initially put the 5 dogs in the same room but a couple of them were showing aggressive tendencies so they let them back out and called us this morning. We were eventually able to contain the 4 dogs. The resident then decided to give us the initial adult female "mom" dog and 5 of the puppies.

- Dog- Fear

The dog that you are adopting has either a history of fearful behavior in their previous home or we have observed the dog exhibiting fearful behavior in the shelter environment. With proper intervention this behavior can be managed in their new home.

Why are dogs fearful?

Some dogs experience a lack of socialization during their critical puppy development periods and may display more fearful behavior in new situations. This behavior can be seen as avoidance, fearful body postures and growling. These experiences can cause the dog to avoid interactions with new people, dogs or other novel stimuli. Sometimes dogs exhibit fairly normal behavior within the environment, but avoid certain types of interaction with people that are new to them. They require a trusting relationship to be comfortable with odd interactions like hugging or raucous play. A risk that any fearful dog can pose is that, when forced to interact with a stimulus (person, dog, new situation) they can react defensively and growl, snap or bite to try to make the scary thing go away. These behaviors need to be managed to help prevent the development of further reactivity. Not every home environment is appropriate for a shy dog; your adoption counselor will help you evaluate your particular situation.

How do I help my dog with its fearful behavior?

- * Understand your dog's threshold. Your dog has a threshold under which they are still able to make good decisions and learn new behaviors. Once they reach their threshold it is best to remove them from the situation and allow them to calm down before working with them again. Once they are back under threshold, the situation may still be challenging for them but it can help to build confidence, reduce stress and help to form positive associations for them.
- * Pay attention to what your dog is saying. Every dog has a progression of behaviors that can build up to an unmanageable level of fear. Knowing when your dog is approaching an uncomfortable point is necessary to help them to either avoid the stimulus or practise calming behavior.
- * Desensitizing and counterconditioning are great tools to teach dogs that scary people or situations are not as frightening as they feel they are. Use treats or wet food to slowly acclimate your dog to the stimulus. Start with the stimulus in a non-threatening form (such as a picture of another dog, or a strange person at a distance). Gradually increase exposure to the stimulus until the dog is comfortable and not expressing any fearful behaviors. By rewarding the dog each time it makes a good decision about the scary stimulus, it will gradually become less and less scary and the dog will begin to have positive associations with it.
- * Make sure to communicate to visitors to your home or strangers on the street how to properly interact with your dog. If it is going to cause your dog too much stress, or they have not progressed to a point in their training where it would be beneficial to the dog, remove them from the situation and do not force an interaction.
