When I arrived I saw that Rune had the toe of the employee's shoe in his mouth, Rune was in his kennel, the employee was on the outside. The way I remember the events are as follows: The employee was using his hands to pull the door toward the employee, so as to keep Rune from getting out of his kennel. The door was being prevented from latching by what the dog was doing. When I arrived, I grasped the kennel door with my left hand at about chest height and also began pulling on the door to insure Rune did not get out. My hand would have been in a fist with some of the knuckles protruding into the kennel. I used my right hand to help free the employee's foot from their shoe. After the shoe was retrieved from Rune's mouth, through the crack in the door, I continued holding the door as it had not been latched. Rune then redirected onto my hand, biting my left middle and ring fingers briefly before letting go. The result was four tares in the skin on my fingers , two on each of the two fingers, all less than about an inch in length. I also have two or three small punctures in the skin, and what appears to be a blood blister.

Unlatched door and he watched me calmly, then darted to bark towards neighbor. Poked the toe of my shoe through the door and he immediately lunged, grabbing on and tugging. I was able to hold door closed against my foot, and radioed for help after 20-45 seconds. A coworker helped pull my shoe off, as he continued to tug, and pet corrector was used. He redirected towards the pet corrector, then grabbed my shoe as I tried to pull it back out of kennel. Airhorn was used and he snapped towards that, then jumped up and bit MH's fingers as MH held door closed. We were able to remove my shoe and latch door. No damage to my foot.

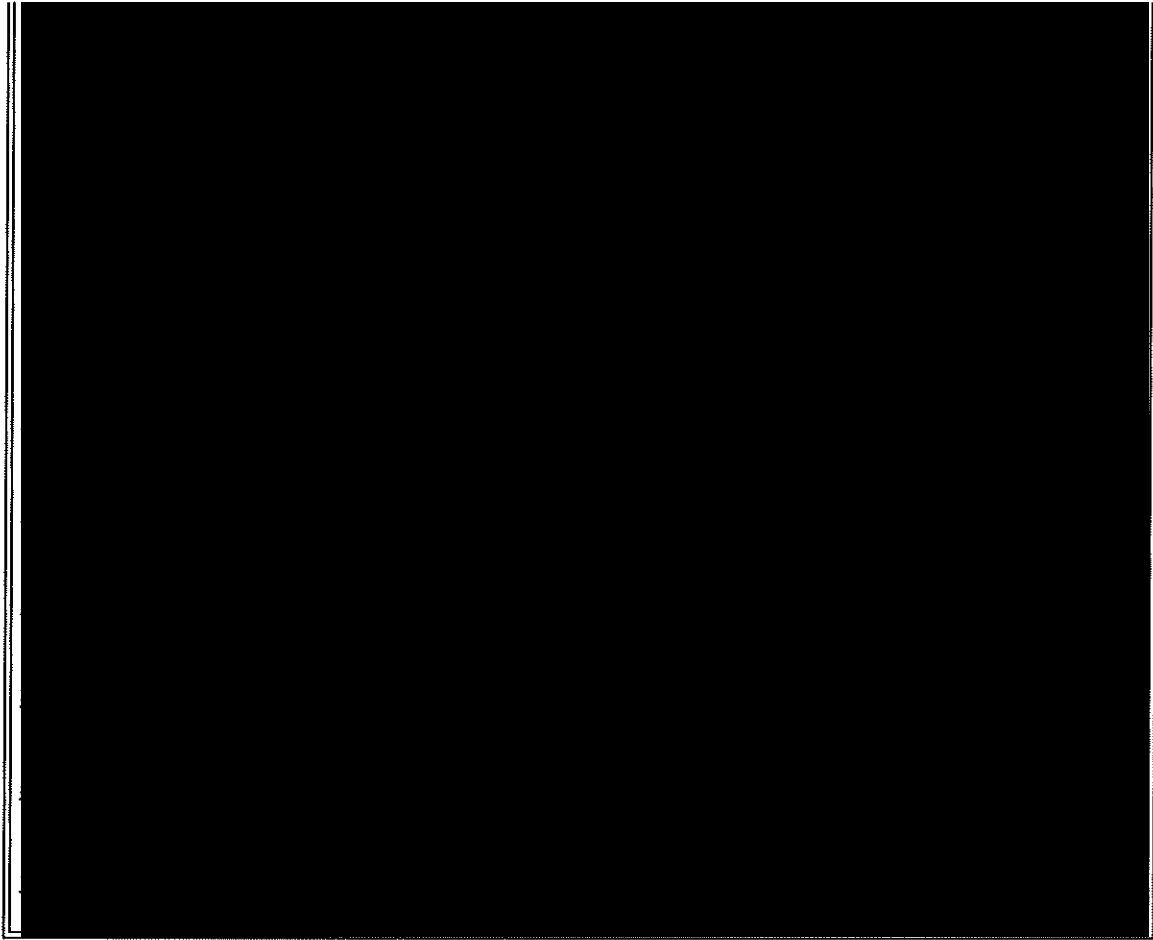

This dog or cat has been diagnosed with allergic skin disease which is a chronic condition. This means they regularly itch or have secondary infections of the skin.

What causes allergic skin disease?

There are several causes of allergic skin disease in animals including parasites, such as fleas, allergies to food, environmental allergies, and a condition called atopy. Atopy is a condition in which there is a defect in the skin's protective barriers allowing for pathogens to stimulate the immune system.

What are the signs?

Signs and symptoms of allergic skin disease include: Itching, scabbing of the skin, hair loss, red skin, skin that appears thickened or discolored, and greasy or flaky skin. Some animals may develop a yeasty odor to their skin.

How is the specific cause diagnosed?

In some cases, like with fleas, a simple visual exam can provide a diagnosis. However, for other causes, blood work, skin scrapes, diet trials, or allergy testing may be needed to provide a diagnosis. Some of the diagnostics do come at a higher cost.

What treatment is needed?

Treatments needed may vary based on the underlying cause. Regardless of the cause, any animal with skin disease should be kept on a regular monthly flea control to help rule out parasites as the cause for their signs. Some animals may require a specialized prescription diet, while others may require daily medications.

What do I need to do next?

MCAS has done a basic work up for skin disease, but is unable to perform more advanced diagnostics. The medical record will indicate what diagnostics have already been done.

An adopter should discuss the care of this animal with their own veterinarian to develop a long-term wellness plan and to discuss all treatment options.

Any future treatments or diagnostics will be the responsibility of the adopter.
