JULIE said she thought that the female dog was possibly pregnant. JULIE mentioned that JASON was trying to rehome the female dog because it was becoming too much to care for two dogs while living in his truck. JULIE said that she hasn't spoken to JASON since 11/17/24 and that he seemed like he had the flu. I asked JULIE if she sees or speaks to JASON to have him call me.

Jason states that he has been sick for a few days and had asked a friend Ryan [REDACTED] to take care of his two dogs. He states that Ryan's landlord is the one who called MCAS because the dogs were not permitted on property. Asked Jason if he was aware of any health concerns/conditions

of the dogs and he stated he was not. Inquired about Ryan's contact information so I could verify that he was responsible for providing care. Jason provided the phone number [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] Attempted to contact Ryan at the number provided. No answer, unable to leave voicemail. Called and spoke to PR Ryan [REDACTED] 238587- He states that he is aware and familiar with Jason and that he was never tasked with pet sitting. He states that he shares the property with 5 other residents, none of which were responsible for them either. Ryan states that he called MCAS because he recognized that the pets had medical concerns and needed more help than he could provide. He was not sure how long the dogs had been on the property but that they could have been coming in going between the yard and the greenhouse on property. Thanked Ryan and ended the call.//jkt

Nov 14 2024 11:21AM Police received a call about a loose pit bull that bit the caller. [REDACTED]

Nov 14 2024 12:12PM 11/14/24 I called and spoke with the PR RYAN. RYAN stated he was walking by when an off leash brindle dog bit his pant leg. RYAN stated that he kicked the dog and then it ran away and ran back to the white truck where it was with another dog. The PR then stated that he banged on the truck for 10 minutes until the owner came out. The PR stated that the owner was uncooperative so he called the police. I asked the PR if the dog bit him at all and he stated that the dog did not. I thanked the PR and advised I would look into the situation and give an update.

Nov 14 2024 12:29PM 11/14/24 approx 11:30 arrived on 111th and observed two pit bull/boxer mix type dogs, one of which was off leash. I recognized the dogs from a previous call as belonging to JASON [REDACTED]. While observing the dogs from the truck a women opened the passenger door to tell the brindle male dog "Walker" to be quiet, I informed the women that her dog was off leash. [REDACTED] and the women were able to pull "Walker" inside the truck. After several minutes [REDACTED] exited the vehicle with "Walker" on leash and came over to speak with us. [REDACTED] stated that he was aware of "Walker" getting off leash and running up to the PR. [REDACTED] said the PR told him he was not bit and was apologetic to the PR about his dog getting loose. [REDACTED] stated he then reattached "Walker's" leash before getting back in the truck. I explained that "Walker" was off leash when we arrived so he must have pulled his collar off again sometime after the incident. We explained due to the repeat incidents of his dogs at large we would be issuing a NOI for "Walker" being at large. [REDACTED] understood, stating he is leaving this area today and the dogs will be in a more secure environment. [REDACTED] tightened "Walker's" collar and said he would keep him in the truck for the remainder of the day. ACO L [REDACTED] issued NOI along with appeals paperwork. We thanked [REDACTED] for his time and cooperation and departed. ACO L [REDACTED] then called PR and informed them of our findings. Complaint closed at NOI.

Nov 9 2024 1:34PM PR states there is an aggressive bulldog tied to mailbox and he is unable to retrieve his mail.

Nov 9 2024 2:59PM 11/9/24 at approx. 1430 myself and officer W [REDACTED] arrived at [REDACTED]. Upon arrival, I observed the two dogs tied to the truck and not the mailbox. However, before I got out of the truck, the owner showed up and took the dogs and began to tie them to the mailbox at 145. Myself and officer W [REDACTED] spoke with JASON and advised he cannot tie his dogs there as the owner's of the house do not have access to their mailbox. JASON apologized and moved the dogs back to his truck. JASON then stated that he is attempting to move from here as his truck doesn't work and he is tired of the neighbors and wants to be closer to his friends. JASON then pointed to another truck where a man was working and stated that his friend is going to try to get him towed off this block. I advised to JASON that would be the best scenario as all of the neighbors are going to keep calling every time he slips up. I then reminded JASON about the leash laws and thanked him. I then went to the PR's house at 145 and spoke with DOMINIC. DOMINIC stated that the dogs were tied out to his mail box and are always loose at night and expressed extreme frustration at the situation. I explained to DOMINIC that I had just spoken to JASON about the mail box issue and that if they see the dogs running loose, take a picture of video if they are able and submit another call. DOMINIC expressed understanding, thanked me, and we departed.

From the truck I observed two dogs tied to the truck and a man outside. I asked the man to come speak with us and he did so. I explained who we were and the reason for our visit. The man, who later introduced himself as JASON [REDACTED] brought each of the dogs into view. I observed one white/tan female dog and one brindle/white male dog, both seeming in good health and body condition. I relayed the reports of his dogs being let off leash at night and explained the leash laws. [REDACTED] said his dogs are always in the truck or on leash eating or on a walk, but understood why we're there and knows he's "under the microscope" given his current situation. I told [REDACTED] that we may continue to receive calls about his dogs but as long as he keeps them on leash and provides water for them at all times then there won't be any issues. I provided [REDACTED] with a low cost resource guide and some dog food, reiterated that he needs to keep his dogs contained or under control at all times, thanked him for his time and departed. RECOMMENDATION: As this is the first reported instance of these dogs being off leash and having explained the leash laws, I am closing complaint at verbal warning. Should I receive picture/video proof of the dogs being off leash in the future, ACO will follow up/NOI may be issued.
