Dog was huddled by inside door of kennel, leaned against it. I slid some treats under door, which he sniffed. Unlatched door and he retreated to back of kennel, eyes wide, ears back, tail low. I entered kennel and crouched down. He approached, and sniffed my leg and treat ouch, hunched low body. Accepted pets on head. I lifted my leash, and he retreated to back corner, looking up, and jumping up on wall, seeking exit. I swung slip lead over his head, and he lay down. I patted my leg and moved towards the door, he stood up and followed. Exited to Intake foyer. FM was in foyer, and crouched down. Dog approached, and pushed head into his lap, accepting contact. Did not move until FM stood up and stepped towards door. Dog followed me to play yard, tail low, and ears back. On the way he had a good sniff with Elektra(350281). Once in yard I crouched down, and he quickly approached me, pressing head into my lap. Accepted pets on head, back, and body. He stepped through slip lead twice, and had no issue with me lifting his feet to reposition it. When I stood up he jumped up and wrapped legs around my leg, holding on for several seconds. Picked up a toy, and shook it for him. His ears perked up, and he chased it when I tossed it, then lost interest. Returned to inside of kennel. He was slightly hesitant passing through doorways. Removed leash and exited kennel without issue.

Observations During Interaction: Brought in by good Samaritan, they were unable to safely get out of their car. When staff approached car, dog was hunkered down behind center console on the floor and between the drivers seat and back seat. 1 handler was able to grab the leash that dog already had on and 2nd handler was able to loop leash from the other side of the car. Was eventually able to get out the car although he did have some resistance and was trying to pull backwards to stay in the car. Once out of the car, he began defecating himself in the parking but handler was able to walk to outside kennel run without issue. Once in the kennel run, dog began panicking jumping up towards handler on the gate, defecating everywhere and acting frantically. Unable to remove slip lead or leash attached to collar at that time without dog attempting to escape kennel. Ended interaction at this point due to high FAS.

- Dog- Fear

The dog that you are adopting has either a history of fearful behavior in their previous home or we have observed the dog exhibiting fearful behavior in the shelter environment. With proper intervention this behavior can be managed in their new home.

**Why are dogs fearful?**

Some dogs experience a lack of socialization during their critical puppy development periods and may display more fearful behavior in new situations. This behavior can be seen as avoidance, fearful body postures and growling. These experiences can cause the dog to avoid interactions with new people, dogs or other novel stimuli. Sometimes dogs exhibit fairly normal behavior within the environment, but avoid certain types of interaction with people that are new to them. They require a trusting relationship to be comfortable with odd interactions like hugging or raucous play. A risk that any fearful dog can pose is that, when forced to interact with a stimulus (person, dog, new situation) they can react defensively and growl, snap or bite to try to make the scary thing go away. These behaviors need to be managed to help prevent the development of further reactivity. Not every home environment is appropriate for a shy dog; your adoption counselor will help you evaluate your particular situation.

How do I help my dog with its fearful behavior?

\* Understand your dog's threshold. Your dog has a threshold under which they are still able to make good decisions and learn new behaviors. Once they reach their threshold it is best to remove them from the situation and allow them to calm down before working with them again. Once they are back under threshold, the situation may still be challenging for them but it can help to build confidence, reduce stress and help to form positive associations for them.

\* Pay attention to what your dog is saying. Every dog has a progression of behaviors that can build up to an unmanageable level of fear. Knowing when your dog is approaching an uncomfortable point is necessary to help them to either avoid the stimulus or practise calming behavior.

\* Desensitizing and counterconditioning are great tools to teach dogs that scary people or situations are not as frightening as they feel they are. Use treats or wet food to slowly acclimate your dog to the stimulus. Start with the stimulus in a non-threatening form (such as a picture of another dog, or a strange person at a distance). Gradually increase exposure to the stimulus until the dog is comfortable and not expressing any fearful behaviors. By rewarding the dog each time it makes a good decision about the scary stimulus, it will gradually become less and less scary and the dog will begin to have positive associations with it.

\* Make sure to communicate to visitors to your home or strangers on the street how to properly interact with your dog. If it is going to cause your dog too much stress, or they have not progressed to a point in their training where it would be beneficial to the dog, remove them from the situation and do not force an interaction.

What if my adopted dog shows fear in the new home?

- Allergic Skin Disease

This dog or cat has been diagnosed with allergic skin disease which is a chronic condition. This means they regularly itch or have secondary infections of the skin.

**What causes allergic skin disease?**

There are several causes of allergic skin disease in animals including parasites, such as fleas, allergies to food, environmental allergies, and a condition called atopy. Atopy is a condition in which there is a defect in the skin's protective barriers allowing for pathogens to stimulate the immune system.

**What are the signs?**

Signs and symptoms of allergic skin disease include: Itching, scabbing of the skin, hair loss, red skin, skin that appears thickened or discolored, and greasy or flaky skin. Some animals may develop a yeasty odor to their skin.

**How is the specific cause diagnosed?**

In some cases, like with fleas, a simple visual exam can provide a diagnosis. However, for other causes, blood work, skin scrapes, diet trials, or allergy testing may be needed to provide a diagnosis. Some of the diagnostics do come at a higher cost.

**What treatment is needed?**

Treatments needed may vary based on the underlying cause. Regardless of the cause, any animal with skin disease should be kept on a regular monthly flea control to help rule out parasites as the cause for their signs. Some animals may require a specialized prescription diet, while others may require daily medications.

**What do I need to do next?**

MCAS has done a basic work up for skin disease, but is unable to perform more advanced diagnostics. The medical record will indicate what diagnostics have already been done.

An adopter should discuss the care of this animal with their own veterinarian to develop a long-term wellness plan and to discuss all treatment options.

Any future treatments or diagnostics will be the responsibility of the adopter.
