- Dental Disease - Procedure Recommended

The cat or dog that you are adopting has been diagnosed with dental disease by our Animal Health staff. A dental procedure, more commonly referred to as a Comprehensive Oral Health Assessment and Treatment (COHAT), which includes full mouth radiographs, probing, scaling and polishing teeth under general anesthesia is recommended within the next 6 months to 1 year. Your veterinarian will be able to give an estimate of cost for this procedure after their initial exam with your pet.

Dental disease in pets, particularly dogs and cats, is a very common health issue. Most veterinarians will recommend pets receive a COHAT annually to maintain their oral health.

Similar to humans, dental disease is caused by a buildup of plaque and mineralized calculus, which harbor bacteria. Bacteria will eventually spread to surrounding structures, causing gum inflammation (gingivitis) and bone loss. As the disease progresses, teeth will begin to fall out. If periodontal disease is left untreated, it can progress and cause other medical issues such as oral pain, tooth loss, oral infections and even systemic disease.

Some breeds (including small breed dogs) are more prone to developing dental disease than others and may require more frequent veterinary visits and care.

Dental disease is highly prevalent in pets, early detection and prevention are crucial. Adopters should expect regular veterinary care for pets diagnosed with dental disease.

- Benign Growths

This animal presented to MCAS with one or more skin growths. Based on a visual examination by a member of the Animal Health team, it is suspected these growths are benign (non-cancerous), such as lipomas (fatty masses) and/or skin tags.

MCAS has not performed diagnostic tests (ex: cytology, biopsy, histopathology) to confirm that the growths are benign, a definitive diagnosis can only be made through such testing.

There is a small possibility they could be or could become malignant (cancerous), change in size or have new growths appear in the future. Monitoring, diagnosing, and treating these growths may require future veterinary care at the adopters own veterinarian.

MCAS strongly recommends adopters follow up with their own veterinarian after adoption regarding these growths.
